## Free services for recipients for MORE

 THAN 12 MONTHS and their children- Examination every year

- Examination and treatment for emergencies
- X-rays and anesthesia
- Scaling (from age 16) and polishing (from age 12)
- Grey fillings for teeth in the back
- White fillings for teeth that are visible in a smile
- Taking out teeth and roots
- Prefabricated crowns
- Surgery
- Root canal (for age 12 and under)
- Fluoride application (age 12 to 15 )


## Free services for recipients for MORE THAN 24 MONTHS and their children

On top of the other treatments

- Complete dentures every 8 years
- Partial dentures in acrylic every 8 years
- Re-coating (redoing the inside) of dentures every 5 years
- Replacement of lost or broken dentures (not repairable) $\rightarrow$ half the price
- Replacement of dentures after a dental surgery
- Repair of dentures

Free services for recipients for LESS THAN 12 MONTHS and their children

In case of emergency

- Control of bleeding
- Treatment of teeth and gum infections (drainage of the tooth or the gum)
- Taking out teeth and roots and giving the required care afterwards
- Treatment of injuries to the tooth or to the mouth (e.g. palate, cheek, tongue)
- Putting back into place a fully uprooted tooth
